LAND Trust Plan 2023-2024

Principal Pam Pedersen shared a revised version of the LAND Trust Plan from 2022-2023 with updates costs for 2023-2024:

Goal #1 – Increase graduation rate.

Counselor \$65,000

Two full-time advocates \$17,000

Counseling intern \$10,00

Goal #2 – Increase math scores.

½ FTE Math teacher \$65,000

Summer work for new math curriculum \$7,000

Goal #3 – Increase RI scores.

Reading teacher \$120,000

Annie Payne shared her version of the LAND Trust Plan for 2023-2024:

Plan for and administer interim tests to 9th and 10th grade classes 3 times/yr.

Hire a ½ time math teacher (the other half contract funded via TSSP budget) so that math is supported in several ways; lower class sizes (3 sections) and allow team teaching opportunities to be expanded (2 sections) \$40,000.

Pay certified math teachers to teach lab time before and/or after school to support/reinforce students learning. \$8,000.

Hire a ½ music teacher contract (other ½ contract matched by the district) to offer music classes all day, offsetting the enrollment numbers in the math classes. \$50,000.

Motion was put to the SCC to include funding for a ½ FTE music teacher contract by taking the funding for the ½ FTE Math teacher.

Motioned and approved 3.22.2022

Motion was put to the SCC to have Principal Pam Pedersen revise her LAND Trust proposal to include a ½ FTE music teacher. This proposal will be emailed to the SCC to review and provide feedback and ask questions. The SCC members will come prepared to the April 10 meeting to motion and approve a LAND Trust Plan for 2023-2024.
