Welcome- Kristien McDonald Calls the meeting to order.

Approval of March 13<sup>th</sup> Minutes- Elizabeth Florence moves to approve the minutes. David Bergstedt seconds the motion.

Approval of March 23 Minutes- Elizabeth Florence moves to approve the minutes. David Bergstedt seconds the motion.

Fundraiser Request- Kristien McDonald asks for a vote to approve the fundraising request by the East High Auto program.

SCC Discussion of Proposed Land Grant Budget- Kristien McDonald goes over a brief overview of the budget plan. Pam Petersen goes over more specific details. Molonai Hola asks for clarification concerning "advocates". Annie Payne would like reassurance that the counseling staff will be the same as last year- no cuts. Annie Payne also would like reassurance that the reading specialist will stay as full time and the math teacher will stay as full time. Pam Pedersen explains that the math teacher will be cut to a 1/2 time position. Pam Pedersen states that there was not enough work to keep a full-time math teacher occupied at East this year and the math teacher was being moved to 1/2 time regardless and independent of SCC budgeting this year. There was not enough work to keep him full time.

Kristien McDonald amends the motion to add a sixth item, "music students be surveyed". The motion passes unanimously.

Brenda Kraack is trying to finalize yearbooks. Brenda Kraack briefly goes over what SIC is and what it does. Brenda Kraack took the cell phone policy from SCC subcommittee to put in front of SIC.

Counseling Center Report- Kevin Waite reports that individual students meeting schedules are ongoing. Counseling center is busy reevaluating seniors' credit and gathering any needed credit recovery.
