Exams will cost **\$99.00 per exam** except **AP Seminar and AP Research** are \$147.

- Students must be registered online for each class via their teacher's **JOIN CODE** by Friday, October 4, 2024. Your teacher will give you their unique JOIN CODE.
- All exam fees are due by Friday, October 25, 2024. Please pay our treasurer, Kim Schneider in person with check or card, or myschoolfees.com. When paying, identify which exam(s) the student will be taking. If paying by check, please make check payable to East High School.
- Exams ordered after October 25, 2024, will incur a late fee of \$40.00.
- ALL Exams must be ordered by Friday, February 28, 2024. No Exams will be ordered after this date.
- **Students requesting accommodations** (with supporting documentation) must do so with [Laura Cheney](#) (in library) before **December 13, 2024** – **No date extension! Important: Accommodations are approved or denied by Collegeboard.**
- See the reverse for AP exam dates and times. Please review the dates and times that correspond with the AP exam(s) your student will be taking.

Late exams will not be administered for any non-school related reasons (e.g. family travel, appointments, etc.). Students involved with spring athletics or other school competitions must check with their coach or sponsor to determine if dates for Region and State competitions will conflict with AP test dates.

- **AP Art and Design students:** May 9, 2025 (8 p.m. ET = 6 p.m. Salt Lake City), is the deadline to submit your three portfolio components as final in the AP Digital Portfolio.
